Pooya Mohseni is an award winning Iranian American actor, writer, filmmaker and transgender activist. Her stage credits include the Pulitzer winning & Tony nominated play *English* on Broadway (Roundabout), an Obie win for *English* off-Broadway (Atlantic) & the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary concert of *The Laramie Project* (Audible).

Film/TV credits include *Law & Order: SVU*, *The Walking Dead: Dead City*, *Terrifier* and *See You Then*.

A survivor of assault, suicide, domestic violence & depression, Pooya shares her story as an immigrant & a trans person growing up in Iran, finding her way to Broadway & becoming an advocate for healing, resilience & inclusivity.

Pooya was part of the advisory committee for The Ackerman Institute's Gender & Family Project & is one of the contributors of the book *Surviving Transphobia*.
